Tool List for the 2-Part Hollow Ornament woodturning project

These are the tools that I used to make the piece in the Demonstration:

3/8" 40/40 Bowl Gouge (and/or 1/2")

1/16" Parting Tool

3/8" Beading and Parting Tool

1/8" Parting Tool

3/8" Spindle Gouge

Spindle Roughing Gouge (or other tool to rough out the blank to a cylinder)

Tool for creating chuck tenons (I use a 3/8" Parting Tool)

1/2" Recess Finisher or Square Ended Scraper to create the recess

Wall Thickness Caliper

Vernier Caliper (for transferring diameter)

Miniature Live Center with Cup Point

Drill chuck and drill bit for depth drilling (I used 1/4"/6mm)

Pin Vise and small Drill Bit for the eye on top

Scroll Chuck the correct size for the tenon on the workpiece (Standard jaws are usually good)

Depth Gauge

Please note: It is not necessary to have all of these tools to make this project! These are what I used, but it is possible to make this project without owning all of these tools.
