Making or repairing your own Bandsaw Blades

Tools & Supplies you will need:

Alignment jig – buy one or make one

Propane torch

Clamps

Silver Solder – Easiest to use has 45% Silver content, with Cadmium. My favorite brand is All-State No. 101

Flux for use with Silver Solder – All-State No. 101 again

Bandsaw Blade stock. Many tooth styles and widths available. We use Starrett brand premium hardback, 3/8" wide 3tpi Hook tooth on the big bandsaw and 1/4" wide 6tpi on the small one.

Heavy duty cutters and tape measure to cut blade stock to length...

Abrasive belt or disk for making joints and cleaning up after the soldering. Don't use the stone wheel on your grinder to grind the solder.

Safety Glasses, Face Shield, or Goggles to protect your eyes!!

Fire Extinguisher nearby!!
