## **Tool List for the Banksia Pod Ornament with Finial woodturning project**

These are the tools that I used to make the piece in the Demonstration:

1/16" Parting Tool  
3/8" Beading and Parting Tool  
3/8" 40/40 Bowl Gouge (and/or 1/2")  
1/8" Parting Tool  
3/8" Finial Gouge  
1/4" Vortex Tool  
Wall Thickness Caliper (for wall thickness)\*  
Short reach Caliper (for wall thickness)\*  
Vernier Caliper (for transferring diameter)  
Miniature Live Center with Cup and Cone Points  
Drill chuck and Forstner Bit for depth drilling  
Pin Vise and small Drill Bit for the eye on top  
Depth Gauge\*

Please note: It is not necessary to have all of these tools to make this project! These are what I used, but it is possible to make this project without owning all of these tools.

\*I didn't need these measuring devices to turn the Ornament out of a Banksia Pod, but would have used them if the Ornament was other material without the holes.
