Image editing software:

Adobe.com – Photoshop (CS5) - \$699, \$380 on ebay

Photoshop version 7 - \$60 approx

Photoshop Elements - \$99.99 , \$45 on ebay

Free trials are usually available before purchase

Buy older versions of software on ebay or from a friend who's upgrading

Photoshop.com – free upload-and-edit site. Download the "uploader" to make syncing easier.

Basic edits, not much control. Very cool: use it on your iphone to edit photos taken with the phone

Photoshop forums: <http://forums.adobe.com/index.jspa>

Search internet for photo editing software – lots of options out there, for free or cheap

Look on your computer for a photo editing program. Basic edits are usually available.

Do not manipulate or color balance

Jpeg preferred

Tiff ok

1400 - 1920 on longest side

baseline standard jpeg (not progressive)

Juried Art Services.com:

1400 – 2000 pixels at largest dimension

1920 x 1920 ok

1920 x 1920 pixels

baseline standard jpeg

under 1.8 MB

sRGB (or RGB) color space

Ebay:

1000 – 1600pixels on the longest side
